- Agree the proposed FSA response to the recommendations.




WG1; 'To advise the Board on how it can be confident that FSA has access to the right science capability and is using science to the best of its ability.'

- 42 recommendations across the 5 themes the Science Council identified as key to FSA's effective capability and use of science.
- FSA response to recommendations is set out in full in 18-12-09 Annex 2.
- The FSA should welcome the report and accept the Working Group (WG) recommendations [subject to two minor points of detail that reflect changes in FSA's governance and organisation since the WG made its report]



Science Assurance Framework





WG2; 'What does the Council advise to be best practice in establishing and communicating risk and uncertainty?'

 15 principles on best practice on establishing and communicating risk and uncertainty which cover the overall process and governance of risk analysis and of its component parts (risk assessment, risk management and risk communication);

• 17 high-level recommendations, for putting these principles into practice and on opportunities for continuous improvement.

Considered to have the benefit of:

- Amplifying the globally recognised frameworks (notably the Codex Principles) which the FSA is already following;
- Being tailored specifically to the FSA;
- Having been developed with input from a wide range of FSA staff working on risk analysis and with input from the FSA's Scientific Advisory Committees; <u>ACSS*</u>
